When determining 150% of the FPG, households with more than eight members must add \$6,810 to the yearly income or \$559. 73 to the 30-day income for each additional member. When determining 175% of the FPG, households with more than eight members must add \$7,945 to the yearly income or \$653.01 to the 30-day income for each additional member.
